The text of this hymn first appears in 1840, in a collection titled "Hymns for the Young." A few years later, the prolific hymn tune writer William Bradbury composed the tune expressly for this text. This arrangement was made by Fred Bock, who served as Director of Music in the Hollywood Presbyterian Church through the end of the last century.
