## About Today's Service

About Today's Music: Today we enjoy the third of our Summer Choir Sundays with the choir set to return to its regular schedule beginning September 10. The anthem is from one of the masses Mozart wrote while he was employed as a court musician to the Prince-Archbishop of Salzburg from 1773 to 1781. "Kyrie eleison, Christe eleison, Kyrie eleison" (Lord have mercy, Christ have mercy, Lord have mercy) is a Greek liturgical term that has its origins in in Eastern Christianity. In Rome, the Liturgy was first celebrated in Greek. The Kyrie remained in Greek as a vestige of a litany at the beginning of the Mass, like that of some Eastern churches, retained after Latin became normative. In our service, the Prayer of Confession serves the function of the Kyrie.

Part of today's liturgy has been adapted from Philip K. Gladden's liturgy for The Presbyterian Outlook
